The members of Dare County Radio Control Flyers, our local radio control model aviation club, will be hosting a flying event at their field in Manns Harbor on Saturday, September, 25 2021 from 10AM to 4PM. Local residents of all ages are invited to attend, and any person attending will be afforded the opportunity to fly one of the club's radio control aircraft!

There is no fee for attending or flying at this event, however the club is asking all those attendees to bring at least one canned good or non-perishable food item per person. These items will be donated to our local food bank by the club following the event. Those attending wishing to try flying a radio control model airplane will be able to do so utilizing an aircraft provided by the club under the supervision of one of the club's flight instructors. Attendees will also be provided with lunch consisting of grilled hot dogs, chips, and a beverage at no cost.
